

Dear parent/carer,

Earlier in the term, I sent out a parental survey to gather parents/carers views of the school at the start of the academic year. This survey also allowed us to gather further valuable information about our school community, including the interests / hobbies and occupations of many of our parents/carers. Throughout the year, as we continue to develop our community links and engagement, I will be drawing upon this information to broaden our children's horizons and develop their awareness of the local community they live in, as well as their wider awareness of what our county, country and the world has to offer. Thank you to all who completed the survey to help us with this.

The second part of the survey was to gather responses with regards to your viewpoint of school. Please find below a summary of information, based on the 116 responses received.

**\*87%** of parents/carer said they are happy with the quality of education school provides.

**\*88%** of parents/carers said their child enjoys being at school.

**\*87%** of parents/carers said their child is safe at school.

**\*80%** of parents/carers said their child is challenged academically at school.

**\*56%** of parents/carers said the school provides quality and sufficient extra-curricular activities, with another **27%** neither agreeing nor disagreeing with the statement.

**\*80%** of parents/carers said school communicates well, with another **19%** who selected 'other' providing a range of feedback with many comments suggesting communication has improved recently.

**\*64%** of parents/carers said challenging behaviour of pupils is dealt with and managed well, with a further **26%** neither agreeing or disagreeing with the statement.

Thank you to all the parents/carers who provided specific comments and opinions on how the school supports your child's learning, wellbeing, provides enrichment / extra-curricular activities and how we engage with you.

We take your feedback from surveys such as this seriously and read each and every comment to reflect and evaluate on how we can further improve things going forward.

We will be conducting a further survey in the summer term to hopefully see a continued improvement in your opinion of school as we strive to build our links with you and engage with our community.
