We are very excited to announce that we have organised a 1-night residential stay at Gulliver's Valley - Theme Park Resort. Not only will our students enjoy the thrills of the amazing rides, but we will also get to experience several other fun and educational activities during our stay. This will link to our topic in class.

We would like to offer this opportunity to all students in years 3 and 4. We will arrive at Gulliver's Valley on Tuesday 5<sup>th</sup> April following an early lunch in school, and return to school on Wednesday 6<sup>th</sup> April in time for the end of the school day. Children will attend school in the morning in comfortable clothing and will have lunch in school before they leave. The cost of the visit will be £59, this includes all activities, accommodation, food and return travel.

Parents/carers able to prove that they are in receipt of certain benefits may be entitled to a reduction in the cost of the visit. If you think you may qualify, please contact Mrs Heydon in the school office who will be able to help you. Please note that the full price of the trip will apply unless you have contacted us in advance.

To confirm our booking, an initial non-refundable deposit of £20 will be required by Friday 25<sup>th</sup> February and the remaining balance of £39 to be made by Friday 18<sup>th</sup> March. This is all paid via Parent Pay.

We are all very excited to be taking the students away on this much deserved educational trip and look forward to receiving your confirmation. Please return the consent slip below to your child's class teacher or the school office by Friday 18<sup>th</sup> February to confirm your child's place.

## **Gulliver's Valley Theme Park Resort – Student Kit List – Residential Stay**

A residential stay at Gulliver's Valley Resort includes amazing theme park rides, it also includes some other fantastic activities where everyday clothes may not be entirely suitable.

We have put together a handy kit list to help you prepare for the visit:

- Small towel / flannel
- Sleeping Bag & Roll Mat (if children wish to bring another form of padding e.g a blow up bed/mattress, they will need to be able to inflate this themselves, therefore just a roll mat is advised)
- Toiletries – toothbrush/toothpaste, soap and hairbrush
- Suncream (weather dependent)
- Cap or Sun Hat (weather dependent)
- Coat (weather dependent)
- Old Shoes, Trainers, Boots or Wellingtons (these may get dirty and wet)
- Suitable old clothes appropriate for the time of year that you visit (children will be taking part in several outdoor activities and could get very muddy)
- Comfortable clothing for night-time activities
- Clothes for bedtime, PJs, Onesie, etc
- Clothing for day 2 along with a spare set of clothing in case they get wet on the theme park attractions before returning to school
- Water Bottle (maybe a spare too)
- Spending money (maximum amount £10.00 in a named purse / envelope)
- Medication including inhalers – if required (clearly labelled with your child's name and instructions for administration which must be handed to staff on the morning of the visit by an adult)
- Children cannot bring any additional food or drink or any personal items that may get lost / misplaced, this includes toys, phones and other electrical equipment. However, they may bring a teddy / item for bedtime
