### KS1 Nativity Tickets & Information

Dear parent/carer,

Hopefully you saw the information we shared in our Christmas Newsletter regarding the KS1 Christmas Show. We are delighted that our **KS1** will be performing their nativity 'Stable Story' to a live audience this year.

The performances will be at **9:30am** and **5:30pm** on **Tuesday 14<sup>th</sup> December**. We appreciate these are different times to in previous years, and will mean quite a late pick-up for children after the evening show, but also hope it will give all parents the opportunity to attend depending on your working hours.

We ask that children return to school promptly at **5pm** to allow them to get ready, they will be finished / ready to be collected at approximately **6:15pm**. They should be dropped off and collected from their classroom like a normal school day.

A limited number of spare tickets may be available nearer the time for those wanting more than one at each showing. A dojo post with a link to a form to request these additional tickets will be put on your child's class page, this will 'go live' at 6pm on that day to make it as fair as possible for all parents to request additional tickets.

Programmes will be available to purchase on entry and are priced at £1. All money raised will be used to buy new books for our KS1 library.

A reminder that all parents must wear a face covering when attending the show unless exempt. You will be asked to scan our NHS QR code check-in on entry to school and to use the hand sanitiser provided. Please maintain social distancing wherever possible whilst in school and remember to wrap up warm as it may be cold due to ventilation measures in place.
