

Dear Parent/Guardian,

I'm pleased to share that our annual sports day is fast approaching. It will take place on Wednesday 25th May, and we would love you to come and support your children. After two summers of parents/carers being unable to attend events in person, it will be great to have our school community together, hopefully in the sunshine, cheering on the children and having a great time together.

KS2 events will start promptly at 9.15am and will be finished by 11.45am. The gates will open at 9.05am for you to take your spot in the designated spectator area and then we kindly ask you leave as soon as the event has finished so children can have their lunch. EYFS and KS1 events will start promptly at 1pm until 2.45pm and the gate will be opened at 12.55pm, again for you to take your spot in the spectator area. At the end of this event, please allow your children to go back to their classrooms so they can be dismissed accordingly. The spectator area will be on the banking part of the field and on the KS1 playground, please don't sit where the mats are as these will be allocated for each class.

Refreshments will also be available from the hut on the playground at a small cost, this will be cash only.

Please ensure your child has their water bottle, PE kit, appropriate footwear, a hat and sunscreen (weather dependent). Although it has been a few years since our last sports day, we are keeping some traditional elements of how we have organised it in the past and are asking children to bring a coloured t-shirt to wear during the event to represent their team colour, which are either emerald, ruby, sapphire or topaz (class teachers will be providing this information ASAP for which colour team your child is in).

Please be aware that due to safeguarding, there is no photography permitted during the sports day events; however, there will be opportunities to take plenty of photographs of your own child.

Should we cancel due to the weather, we have booked in Wednesday 8th June as a reserve day.

Let's get ready and remember to pack your own trainers as there will be parent races again this year! We look forward to seeing you on the day.
