

Whitby 2022 Kit List

This is a suggested list of items for your child to take. It would be helpful if items are marked with your child's name.

- **Rucksack or back-pack for carrying belongings around during the day (the bag will need to be carried so will need to have 2 sturdy straps)**
- A suitcase or large holdall
- Strong footwear/trainers for walking
- Slippers
- Socks (3-4 pairs)
- Trousers for outdoors (track-suit/jogging bottoms/jeans)
- Shorts (depending on the weather)
- 1-2 warm jumper/sweatshirt
- Clothing to change into for the evenings
- Underwear for 3 days
- Nightwear
- Comb/hair-brush
- Washing & teeth-cleaning equipment, including shampoo and deodorant
- Large towel for the shower
- Bag - for dirty washing
- Sun cream & sun hat
- Waterproof coat/jacket
- Water bottle
- **Lunch box**
- Any medication needed – please note this must be named and given to a member of staff for safe storage.

Personal Belongings

Mobile phones and smart watches **will not** be permitted on the trip. If your child would like to take a camera, they can bring a one to take photos during the visit. Children may take personal belongings, but they will be expected to be responsible for their own property. These might include the following items: small game e.g. travel game, book/magazine, teddy/mascot, torch, own pencils/pens/crayons, watches, cameras. Whilst every effort would be made to recover a lost item, the school **cannot** be held responsible.

Additional Information

- **If any of the contact details on the completed forms change (particularly telephone numbers), please inform school as soon as possible.**
- If your child suffers from travel sickness, medication should be taken prior to departure. Any additional doses required should be handed in for use during the week (including the return journey).
- All medication (including inhalers) **MUST** be clearly labelled with your child's name and handed in to class teachers before departures.
- **Mobile phones are not to be taken.**
- Your child is allowed to take a maximum of £10 - £15 spending money which should be placed in a purse/wallet clearly labelled with your child's name. School **cannot** accept any responsibility for lost money.
