# Accommodation

- Just on the racecourse which we have access to using a private path from the hostel
- Large dining room
- Separate 'chill out' space where we will be able to run evening activities, including a large TV screen
- All rooms sleep 2-4 people
- En-suite bedrooms





## Safety and information



- They are all en-suite rooms, so children have their privacy.
- The hostel are used to school groups and have schools staying all year round
- We have booked the main building out – only Aston Hall there.
- Front door will be locked at night and there is 24 hour security at reception.
- There are two floors and adults will be placed on each floor.
- Children have key cards for their rooms. These will be handed in to an adult when leaving the hostel.
- The adult keys can access any room in the hostel.

# How will we get around?



- 30-40 minute walk into the centre depending on the attraction we are going to.
- Our coach will drop us off and pick us up on the first and last day
- We will be taking the bus on the second day to return to the hostel
- All attractions are close together in the centre.
- We will be split off into small groups; each group with an adult.
