AREAS OF LEARNING



Autumn Term Learning Questions:

'Who lives in the Woods?' and 'Can you take care of me?' In the Autumn term we will cover autumnal changes, nocturnal animals and people who help us. At the end of this term, the children will also take part in a Nativity Performance.

Spring Term Learning Questions:

'Can you read me a Story?' and 'Who is your Hero?' During this term children will learn traditional tales/fairytales and children will explore what makes a super hero – not all heroes wear capes!

Summer Term Learning Questions:

'Do Cows drink Milk?' and 'Who lives in the Sea?' During the Summer term children will learn about farmyard animal life cycles and may see this with their own eyes when we have some special little visitors! Children will also learn all about the seaside and sea creatures and will enjoy a school trip to Cleethorpes.
