KS5

Also within these sessions, students complete tasks designed to improve their study skills, such as organisation and time management.

- Each week, Y13 students attend a lecture covering a wide range of topics. These sessions are carefully crafted to reflect the key principles of the School Way. They're designed to increase students' motivation, organisation, general knowledge and employability - ultimately preparing them for their life during, and after sixth form.
- Students' preferred Post-18 destinations are identified early, and they're then signposted towards guidance and support. External speakers, and off-site visits are arranged for students when relevant.

- Our Get Work Ready work experience programme – this includes a mix of classroom input sessions and a six-week work experience internship within Wickersley Partnership Trust. Areas include: Finance, Clerical/Business Admin, Reception, Data, IT Support, Human Resources, Site Management, Teaching Assistant, Media, Technical Support (D&T / Science / PE) and Sport Coaching (outdoor pursuits)
