
Throughout the day, children will have the opportunity to take part in a range of book/reading related activities such as creative writing, storytelling, drama, arts and crafts.

and classroom bookshelves and raise a new generation of confident and engaged readers and we would love your support to do the same for our school.



As part of our World Book Day celebrations and to help to encourage a love of books and reading at home, we will be running a sponsored reading event – Ready, Steady Read – between Monday 27th February and Sunday 5th March 2023.



The project is being organised in conjunction with Jacki, our local Independent Usborne Partner, and all the money raised will go towards brand new books for school.
