



Dear parent / carer,

On Friday 5th May, the children at Aston Hall J&I will be taking part in a 'King's Coronation Celebration Day'.

On this day, we are having a non-uniform day (no charge or donations required), where we are encouraging children to either dress in patriotic colours of Red, White and Blue, or to come dressed to impress for our coronation celebrations. This might be smart clothes or even fancy dress as a royal, such as the king himself or a prince, princess etc. Children can also wear any non-uniform of their choice should they prefer.

In addition to non-uniform, we will be having a special Coronation themed lunch, with a menu in the style of a royal picnic, served outside all together (or inside depending on the weather). The special lunch menu will be posted on dojo straight after this. Children will be able to choose the themed lunch or will need to bring a packed lunch from home (there will be an online form link in addition to the menu to gather numbers so the kitchen can order appropriate quantities of food).

During next week, the children will be producing different craft items in school, including bunting, flags, crowns etc. Your child's class teacher may also be setting homework related to this. If you would like to contribute anything to help decorate classrooms for the day, then please feel free to give anything to your child's class teacher to add to what we will already be purchasing / creating.

In addition to Coronation themed activities in classes throughout the day, we will also be hosting a special 'Royal Celebration Assembly' where each class will have a King & Queen of the week in place of our usual celebration awards.
