Aston Hall Open Evening – Wed 12<sup>th</sup> July – 4-6pm

On this day, school will be 'open' from 4-6pm for our Summer Open Evening. This is a great opportunity for parents/carers and children to come into school to both reflect on the current year, and look forward to the next. This will be an informal event where class teachers will be in their classrooms and available for informal discussions with you about your child's progress this year. Your child's workbooks will also be in their tray on their desk and available for you to look at and discuss with them / their teacher. There will also be an opportunity for you and your child to visit their classroom for September, including meeting their new teacher. Further details to be shared nearer the time and we will be informing you in advance of the open evening which class your child is in next year.

Transition – Wed 19<sup>th</sup> & Thurs 20<sup>th</sup> July


On Wed 19<sup>th</sup> & Thurs 20<sup>th</sup> July, all children currently in school will move up to their new classrooms with their new teachers. You will need to drop your child off at their new classroom and pick them up from there also, just like you will in September. Staff will be available on the yard to direct you as needed to the correct classrooms, and teachers will be on their doors if you are unsure. The children will enjoy two days of transition events, getting to know their new classmates and their new teacher. Further details to follow, including where our Y6 pupils will be in school during these two days.

Final day of the school year – Friday 21<sup>st</sup> July

On this day, children and staff will return to their current / normal classroom and enjoy a final morning of celebrations in their current class prior to school closing at 1:15pm. You will need to drop-off and collect your child from their current class on this day, unlike the Wed & Thurs.
