Eureka! The National Children's Museum Trust Visit

Dear Parent/Carer,

Year 3 and Year 4 students will be going on a visit to Eureka! The National Children's Museum in Halifax on Wednesday 14th June 2023.

The purpose of this visit is to explore technology, consolidating our Science learning.

The visit leaders will be Miss Davenport, Mrs Booth and Mr Steeple. Students will be travelling by Maxfield's coach company. All relevant risk assessments have been completed.

The trip will depart at 8.30am and we aim to return at approximately 4:15pm. As the trip is in school time, in case of emergency please contact the school office.

Students will need to be in school for 8:15am in order to register before we leave. They will need to bring a packed lunch and drink (not in a glass bottle). If your child is in receipt of free school meals and you'd like a packed lunch provided by us, please inform your child's class teacher. Students will be expected to wear school uniform and have suitable footwear.

We are asking for a voluntary contribution of £19 per child. We recognise that this is an expensive trip, but due to increases in costs of coach travel and insurance, this is unavoidable. The following shows a breakdown of the costs;

Entry to Eureka £8.67

Coach £10.33

Please note that school have subsidised some of the cost per pupil. However, in the event of an inadequate number of contributions being received, it may not be possible for the visit to take place.
