Open Evening & Transition Plans

Dear parents/carers,

Please find full details below of our open evening & transition plans taking place in July. We shared some information regarding this on our calendar dates update at the beginning of the month, with full details provided below including an important form for you to complete with your child.

Parent & Pupil voice to support transition

As part of our transition into new classes for September, we wanted to gather some parent and pupil voice that will be helpful for receiving teachers to have to better understand their incoming class, especially given the information is coming directly from you / your child. Aston Hall Open Evening – Wednesday 12th July – 4-6pm

On this day, school will be 'open' from 4-6pm for our Summer Open Evening. This is a great opportunity for parents/carers and children to come into school to both reflect on the current year, and look forward to the next. This will be an informal event where class teachers will be in their classrooms and available for informal discussions with you about your child's progress this year. Your child's workbooks will also be in their tray on their desk and available for you to look at and discuss with them / their teacher. There will also be an opportunity for you and your child to visit their classroom for September, including meeting their new teacher. You can use this time to familiarise yourself with the classroom, drop-off / pick-up points and have informal discussions with their teacher. The event will run from 4-6pm. From 4-5pm, teachers will be in their current classrooms, and from 5-6pm in their new classrooms (if they are moving classrooms next year).

Transition – Wednesday 19th & Thursday 20th July

On Wednesday 19th and Thursday 20th July, all children currently in school will move up to their new classrooms with their new teachers. You will need to drop your child off at their new classroom and pick them up from there also, just like you will in September. Staff will be available on the yard to direct you as needed to the correct classrooms, and teachers will be on their doors if you are unsure. The children will enjoy two days of transition events, getting to know their new classmates and their new teacher. We are hopeful that Miss Woodcock will be joining us for these two days.

Our current Y6 children will be based in our hall and will need to be picked up / dropped off from the old IT suite door near the hub building if they don't arrive on their own / have permission to leave school. They will be taking part in a two-day project / celebration with staff in school.

Final day of the school year – Friday 21st July

On this day, children and staff will return to their current / normal classroom and enjoy a final morning of celebrations in their current class prior to school closing at 1:15pm. You will need to drop-off and collect your child from their current class on this day, unlike the Wed & Thurs.
