<u>Y6 National Coal Mining Museum Visit</u>

Dear Parent/Carer,

We are excited to share with you that Year 6 will be visiting the National Coal Mining Museum on **Thursday 29<sup>th</sup> February.** The day will include an underground mine tour, access to mining exhibitions and access to the discovery centre.

We are asking for a voluntary contribution of £13.18 per child. We recognise that this is an additional expense but due to increases in costs of coach travel and insurance, this is unavoidable. The following shows a breakdown of the costs; Entry to National Coal mining Museum £3.74 and Coach £9.45.

Please note that school will be subsidising some of the cost per pupil. However, in the event of an inadequate number of contributions being received, it may not be possible for the visit to take place.

We will be departing school at approximately **9:00am** so children need to ensure they arrive at school promptly at 8:30am. We will return to school at approximately **3:30pm**.

Year 6 will require a packed lunch and water bottle for this visit. If your child is normally entitled to free school meals, please contact your child's class teacher if you would like us to order them a grab bag by Monday 19<sup>th</sup> February.

Students will be expected to wear school uniform and a warm waterproof coat. Please note that the museum is an outdoor site and covers rough terrain so students will need suitable footwear.
