Cost of the total trip

Adults going...



Accommodation - Gully Town



All children and staff will sleep in the same room - it is very large with different zones.

There are 2 floors, but all children and staff will be on the upper floor together overnight.





Safety and information



- There are 2 toilets in the room, and more downstairs. Children will be taken to the downstairs facilities by adults in small groups.
- Doors accessing our designated area will be locked at night
- A night porter is on duty throughout the night.
- One other school group (of Y4 children) will be on site during our stay but they will be in separate areas at all times, except for meals.

Getting there & back



- Drop children at Gulliver's Valley (main building entrance) at 10am on 18th April.
- For anyone unable to drop at Gulliver's, please bring children to school at normal time and a small minibus will transport them from school to Gulliver's.
- Collect from Gulliver's at 2pm on Friday 19th. Remaining children will be brought back to school on a minibus.

Meals



- Children need to have breakfast at home on Thursday 18th and bring a packed lunch to eat at Gulliver's that day.
- *Food options will be confirmed by the venue but are likely to be;
- Tea - chicken nuggets or pizza with chips
- Breakfast - sausage and hash brown sandwich.
- Lunch on 19th - ham or cheese sandwich, crisps, fruit, muffin
- Drinks (water or squash) are provided with every meal and there are facilities where children can fill up a reusable water bottle throughout the day.

Things we will be doing...

- ✓ Indoor play centre including caving, inflatable bouncy castle and climbing wall
- ✓ Outdoor Bushcraft activities (e.g. shelter building, fire lighting, nature trail)
- ✓ Half day theme park access
- ✓ Evening entertainment



Medication

- If your child requires any medication, a medication form must be completed before we go, and any medication must be clearly labelled and handed to their class teacher when they are dropped off at Gulliver's or school.
- Children **MUST NOT** carry their own medicine.
- Please make sure doses and times are clearly stated on the medical form before handing it back in.
- Medical forms will be handed out nearer the time.



What to take/not take



- ✓ Sleeping bag
- ✓ Roll mat
- ✓ Pillow
- ✓ Small cuddly toy for comfort - if needed
- ✓ Small towel
- ✓ Reusable water bottle

✓ Maximum spending money of £10 which should be labelled with your child's name in a purse/wallet

(School cannot be responsible for children's items/money)

No mobile phones on trip (school will contact you if there is an emergency)

No electronic equipment – i.e. iPads etc

Kit List

Sleeping Bag & Roll Mat

Pillow (optional)

Small face towel/flannel

Toiletries (toothbrush, toothpaste, hairbrush/comb, bobble)

Cap or Sun Hat (if weather is warm)

1 Rain Jacket or Warm Coat (weather dependent)

Old Shoes, Trainers, Boots or Wellingtons (these may get dirty and wet)

2 sets of old outdoor clothes (e.g. T-shirt, jumper, leggings/joggers)

1 set of comfy clothes for our evening entertainment (indoor only)

2 sets underwear

3 pairs socks

Woolly Hat, Gloves and Scarf/Snood (if weather is cold)

Pyjamas/nightwear

Reusable Water Bottle

Spending Money (Maximum amount - £10.00) in a purse/wallet labelled with child's name

Medication – if required (Clearly labelled with your name).

1 black bin bag (for wet clothes) & 1 carrier bag (for wet/dirty shoes) – both labelled with your child's name
