Maths

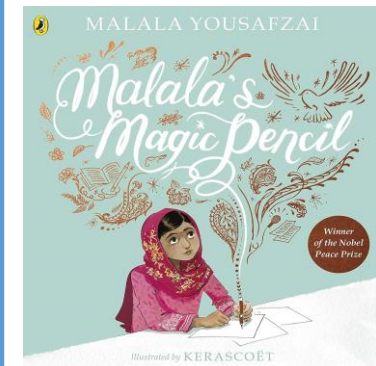
Find and record number bonds to 20. Can you record them systematically? You could use counting objects such as sweets, beads or bricks to help you.
