## Colour Run

Dear Parent/Carer,

On **Friday 17<sup>th</sup> May**, Y6 have been invited to attend a Colour Run at Rawmarsh Community School in order to raise money for Bluebell Wood. We felt this would be a really fun and exciting way to end the week after completing all of our SATs papers whilst also being a great opportunity to raise money for charity!

The event will take place in the morning so will not affect dinnertime. The children will be travelling to and from Rawmarsh via minibus and there is no cost for transport.

Although the paint is washable, we cannot guarantee that all paint residue will wash out of clothing so Y6 will need to bring clothes that they don't mind getting paint on- we suggest old clothes and trainers- lighter colours will make the paint show up better! We also ask that children wear shorts and a top underneath their Colour Run clothes and bring a plastic carrier bag with them so that they can put their paint-covered clothes in it to travel back on the minibus at the end of the event. The children might also want to pack sunglasses/goggles to wear in order to avoid paint getting in their eyes.

As this is an opportunity to raise money for Bluebell Wood, it'd be fantastic if the children could gather some sponsors! This can be done by following the Just Giving QR code on this letter. Colour Run merchandise will be on sale on the day ranging from between 50p-£2 per item, so if the children would like to, they can bring a small amount of money with them to buy something to wear during the run. Please note, children will be responsible for their own money, and this needs to be in a labelled envelope/wallet.
