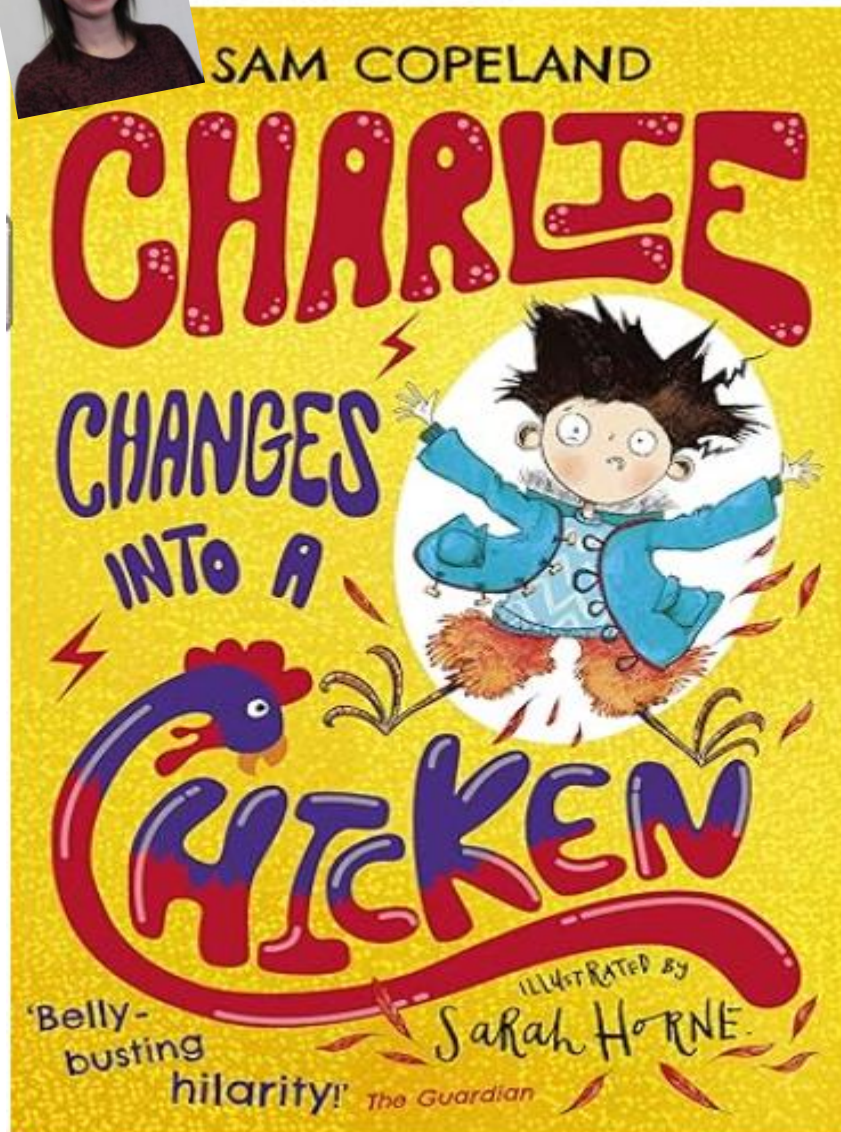




Mrs Booth recommends...



This month's recommendation for KS2 pupils is *Charlie Changes into a Chicken*. I read this book with my children during lockdown and it had us laughing out loud together often!

Charlie has an incredible secret... when he gets worried, he changes into all sorts of animals – a flea, a pigeon and even a rhino! The worry for Charlie is that he has lots to worry about, but his best friends are there to try and help him deal with his crazy superpower.

This book taught us lots of new things; apparently, the scientific name for a snake is 'danger noodle' and spiders don't have 8 bums!

For anyone who loves reading Roald Dahl or David Walliams, this is a great book to try next and it will be available to borrow from the 'recommended reads' display in our school library.
