Eureka! The National Children's Museum Trust Visit

Dear Parent/Carer,

Year 3 and Year 4 students will be going on a visit to Eureka! The National Children's Museum in Halifax on Thursday 19th June 2025.

The purpose of this visit is to explore technology, consolidating our Science learning.

The visit leaders will be Mr Woodcock, Mrs Booth and Mr Steeple. Students will be traveling by Maxfield's coach company. All relevant risk assessments have been completed.

The trip will depart at 8.30am and we aim to return at approximately 4:15 pm. As the trip is during school time, in case of an emergency please contact the school office.

Students will need to be in school for 8:15 am to register before we leave. They will need to bring a packed lunch and drink (not in a glass bottle). If your child is in receipt of free school meals and you'd like a packed lunch provided by us, please inform your child's class teacher. Students will be expected to wear school uniforms and have suitable footwear.

We are asking for a voluntary contribution of £24.50 per child. We recognise that this is an expensive trip, but due to increases in costs of coach travel and insurance, this is unavoidable.
