Dear Parents/Carers of FS2 children,

This term, we will be visiting Cleethorpes to help support our learning question for the Summer 2<sup>nd</sup> half term, 'Who lives in the sea?' The main aims of the visit are to explore the features of the seaside environment and learn new geographical vocabulary like pier, coast, shoreline etc. We will also be exploring the beach e.g. finding treasure/shells and taking part in collaborative sand castle building activities and team games.

Children should wear their school top, but may choose comfortable summer bottoms for the trip. Please ensure that your child wears comfortable shoes (e.g. trainers that are suitable for walking and running on the beach - no flip flops/sandals please), and brings a lightweight waterproof coat in case of rain. Please ensure your child brings a sun hat and that sun cream is applied before school that day (Ideally, 8hr sun cream that lasts the whole day. However, we will reapply if necessary). The children may bring a small rucksack with a bottle of water in and a small bucket/spade if they wish (both should fit inside their rucksack).

To get a real taste of the seaside, we will be visiting a fish & chip restaurant for lunch. They will have a choice of fish or sausage and chips. Please specify on the google form the lunch your child would like or alternatively, they could bring a packed lunch. We will also be taking the children for an ice cream and they will have a choice of a vanilla Mr Whippy with/without a flake. The children will not need snacks/food on the visit, just their water bottle.

This visit will take place on Friday 20th June 2025. We would like the children to come to school early on this day at 8:10am, as the coach will be leaving school at approximately 8.30 am. We will aim to return to school at a later time of 3:40pm and children will be dismissed from the classroom, as usual.

The cost of the visit is £19 to be paid on ParentPay to cover the cost of transport, insurance, lunch & ice cream. This is a voluntary contribution, however if there are insufficient contributions the visit will unfortunately be unable to take place.
