

### Y6 CRUCIAL CREW VISIT

Dear Parents/Carers,

We are pleased to share that on **Thursday 23<sup>rd</sup> October**, our annual trip to **Crucial Crew** will take place. Y6 will be heading to the specially designed set at The Lifewise Centre, Hellaby, where they will get the opportunity to work with people from all of the emergency services.

They will participate in role play scenarios that will help them prepare for situations they may encounter in real life, including the dangers of fire, cyberbullying, medical emergencies, peer pressure, and they will even get the chance to work with a magistrate, performing a script in which a ten-year-old is taken to court for criminal behaviour.

We've taken the Y6 children to Crucial Crew for many years and the experience is always invaluable in helping them prepare for secondary school, as well as becoming independent and responsible young people. We look forward to them participating in the activities and following this up with discussions and learning through our PSHE scheme back at school.

We will **leave school at 8:55am**, and therefore children need to be at school **on time** for the usual time of 8:35am. We will return to school before the **normal finish time of 3:20pm**. As we will be there all day, **a packed lunch and drink will be required**. If your child is entitled to free school meals, please contact your child's class teacher to request a school packed lunch by Friday 17<sup>th</sup> October.
